She creates quilts using wholecloth painting or raw edge appliqué. Then she thread paints the quilt to bring it to life. Her quilts have been juried into local and national quilt shows. She was featured in June 2019 Quilting Arts magazine as well as Quilting Arts TV.

Whole cloth Painting :: Blooming Poppy

Learn the basics of painting on prepared for dying (PFD) fabric. Student will learn techniques to create a whole cloth painted poppy.

Student will learn:

- how to transfer poppy image to fabric
- basics of mixing textile paints
- best practices for applying paint to PFD fabric
- quilting and finishing technique

Workshop is \$35 for members and \$55 for non members and includes a kit.
