Focus: Cut TWENTY-EIGHT 6 1/2 -inch

Colors B&C: Cut Five 3 ½ -inch strips from both colors each, make strip sets, then cut into	
$3\frac{1}{2}$ -inch units. Sew into TWENTY-EIGHT 4-	
patch blocks.
