## **Message from the Vice President**

### A Quilters Best Friend

Thread Wax, an oldie but goodie, can be used to keep thread from knotting and twisting

while hand stitching ( bindings, labels, hemming).

Also great for: Hand Quilting

Embroidery

Candlewicking

Metallic Embroidery Floss


Smocking

To use: Pull thread thru slots and across wax

If you cannot find in quilt shops - try JoAnn Fabrics.

Can also use candle or block of beeswax.

Other recommended products that I have seen on-line are 'Thread Heaven' and 'Thread Magic' to use for thread drag.
