### **Workshop**

July Workshop: "A Modern Slant on A Vintage Apron"

Some members may remember the program that Lee Ann Williams did on the April 2021 zoom meeting.

The program featured a Vintage Apron that would be a lovely Hostess Apron.

The apron is by "The Sweet Tea Girls" - a company from Clayton, NC, which was started by a retired IBM engineer. The Instructions (not patterns) are meticulous. The designs are symmetrical and balanced eclectic styles.

The Apron has a gored skirt design. It was inspired by a Vintage Apron found at an antique shop in the hill country of Texas and requires 4 - 5 fat quarters OR 1 &1/4 yards of fabric.

Bring Fabric, thread, scissors, ruler, and sewing machine.

The Vintage Apron makes a lovely gift. You will want to make them in various seasonal color combinations.
