Shop News: Patty Blanton. The Shop Hop starts next Sat., a total of 12 fabric stores participate. If you buy a \$3 passport, you get a free \$3.00 pattern, 25% off coupon for fabric, & a free fat quarter. Sew Original has gotten a long arm quilting machine. If you want to train to use it, it costs \$100, then if you wish to quilt using it, it costs \$18 per hr. The quilting pattern chosen determines how long it takes to quilt; if the quilting is dense it takes longer than for a bigger design. Patty will have a hand stitching club monthly, sashiko and chicken scratch stitch.


